Arriving in Erevan during the first half of January, 1918, Aram organized a committee which served as an unofficial administration. It expelled several Armenian bandit groups from the city, levied special taxes on the residents, confiscated stores of matériel abandoned by the Russian troops, and, in violation of the Commissariat's instructions, conscripted hundreds of men.
