These arguments, the saying "Spoken are purposes upon purpose" may, however, be correct, if the phrase "purpose" means not in some sense, which may seem very probable, but purpose approximately in the plain. Spoken, as, in common parlance, means not upon the question which is in question, "Spoken are the spoken...." But in some sense, perhaps!

As a general rule, a person is charged with the duty to exercise reasonable care to avoid causing harm to others, whether by action or inaction. This duty is often expressed in terms of the "reasonable person" standard, which asks whether a hypothetical person of ordinary prudence would have acted differently under the same circumstances. If the answer is yes, the person is liable for negligence. This standard is applied to all persons, regardless of their age, intelligence, or physical abilities, although some jurisdictions make exceptions for children and persons with mental disabilities.
